AmericanLegionRiders.net is committed to protecting your online privacy while providing you with access to useful ALR information and communications. While you can use many features of AmericanLegionRiders.net anonymously, you are required to provide personal information to gain access to some of our content and services.

How we collect and use personal information

Registering for membership within the Forum, Regional Information Center, and Mailing List servers on AmericanLegionRiders.net gives you access to all related application('s/s') information and features. The extent of the information required is your real name, e-mail address, ALR Post number, ALR City, and ALR Department. We do all in our power to ensure your contact information is not available to the general public; however, in several applications (Forum, RALRIC), this information is generally available only to those who have also registered in a like manner.

By registering within these applications, you agree to make this information available to other members. Further, you acknowledge that you expect occasional mailings required to disseminate information and/or manage your access to the site and its applications. Also by registering on this site, you specifically agree to hold harmless The American Legion, any and all of its officers and sub-organizations (ALA, SAL, ALR) and the NALRIC Webmaster in the event that your information is inadvertently exposed to the public.

If you contact the Webmaster with an email advertising an event, providing your contact information within that email, it will be replicated on the site. Your email to the Webmaster is indication of your permission to do so.

Further, use of the National Events Calendar requires your contact information be provided when submitting events to the NEC in order that you may be contacted in the event that there is an issue with your posting. This information is internal to the application, and, barring systems failure, not exposed. The NEC also required that a posting provide contact information such that interested parties might obtain more information regarding your event. This information is intentionally exposed to the public in general. It is the responsibility of the person(s) creating the calendar entry to ensure it is appropriate to publish the contact information in this manner. The NALRIC Webmaster reviews entries solely for applicability to the purposes of the ALR only, and will not attempt to verify that you have obtained permission to publish any individual('s/s') information. **RELIEF:** In the event that contact information has been inappropriately listed within the NEC, contact the webmaster, citing the date and event name, to have the entry removed from the calendar. The American Legion, any and all of its officers and sub-organizations (ALA, SAL, ALR) and the NALRIC Webmaster will not be liable for any consequences of this publication; however, and will only be responsible for the timely removal of the entry following such notification. The American Legion, any and all of its officers and sub-organizations (ALA, SAL, ALR) and the NALRIC Webmaster can also not be held liable for any occurrence which may interfere with the timely removal of said entry.



Officer Contact Information collected via the Chapter Data Form is stored in a single-instance, central database, which is not accessible on or attached to the internet. This information is provided to listed ALR Chapter officers, or to requesting officers of appropriate American Legion organizations (TAL, ALA, SAL), upon pertinent and approved request. Specific Director and Assistant Director names, email addresses, and phone numbers are also provided in response to information requests by prospective members located near the subject Chapter. This information is *NEVER* disseminated as a whole to any third party, except as already noted. In short, we do not and will not sell your contact information, nor intentionally make it available to advertisers.

How we protect your personal information

Any financial data you enter on AmericanLegionRiders.net website is encrypted with secure server software (SSL) that encodes the information before your Web browser software sends it. The SSL software decodes the data only after it reaches our financial clearinghouse server, meaning hackers can't snatch this information while it is in transit. The data is decoded at the financial site we use as a clearinghouse (PayPal.com. See their site for their privacy policies.), and is **never** in our possession.

Contact data, except for as noted above, is stored internally to the registered members-only applications in which the data is entered, and is not made available to the general public.

Though it is not beyond reason that someone may breach our systems and gain access to your email address, this is as sensitive as the data stored on the NALRIC servers ever gets.

How we use "cookies"

As you probably know, "cookies" are small pieces of information that some Web sites store on your computer's hard drive when you visit them. Like many other Web sites, AmericanLegionRiders.net uses cookies to identify members so they don't have to enter a user ID and password upon each visit. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies but allow you to modify security settings so you can approve or reject cookies on a case-by-case basis. Cookies are required to access the Forum and the Regional Information Center. If cookies are disabled, these applications will not function for you.

What we provide to third parties

AmericanLegionRiders.net does not provide any third-party access to your personal information.

Obtaining your consent

By using our Web site, you give AmericanLegionRiders.net permission to collect information about the pages served to you as an anonymous user for the purpose of calculating aggregate site statistics. If you register at AmericanLegionRiders.net for any of the online applications mentioned above, you authorize AmericanLegionRiders.net to use information you provide to personalize the information we deliver to you and to use your demographic information when calculating aggregate user data. As a registered member, you give AmericanLegionRiders.net and our affiliates (ALR Chapters, site users, TAL, ALA, SAL) permission to send you e-mails related to the subscription e-mail services to which you subscribe and regarding Legion, ALA, SAL, and ALR issues and events.

If you are under the age of 18, you must not provide your name, e-mail address, or any other identifying information without the consent of your parent or guardian, or as otherwise provided for by applicable law.

Any changes to our privacy policy will be posted on this page so that you are always aware of what information we collect, how we use it, and under what circumstances we disclose it.
